Introduction

We understand that you are aware of and care about your own personal privacy interests, and we take that seriously. This Privacy Statement describes policies and practices of Infosec Cloud Ltd (Infosec Cloud) regarding its collection and use of your personal data and sets forth your privacy rights. We recognise that information privacy is an ongoing responsibility, and so we will from time to time update this Privacy Statement as we undertake new personal data practices or adopt new privacy policies.

Who we are?

Infosec Cloud is based in Basingstoke, England. We are registered as Infosec Cloud Ltd in England (Companies House registration number 06035236) and we are registered with the Information Commissioner's Office under registration number ZA304649.

The data we collect and process

- Client data
- Data about customers and employees of our clients
- Visitors to our website
- Marketing data

Client data:

We collect personal information about our clients and customers to provide them with IT security and compliance solutions, training and other IT professional services.

We will hold the following information about clients:



- Name and contact information.
- Personal information contained in business communications.
- Transaction data including details about services you have purchased from us.
- Usage data including information about how you use our product and services.
- Marketing and Communications data including your preferences in receiving marketing material from us and your communication preferences.

How is your personal data collected?

You may give us your Identity, Contact and Financial Data by filling in forms or by corresponding with us by post, phone, email, web-forms or otherwise. This includes personal data you provide when you:

- engage us to provide services;
- subscribe to our publications;
- request marketing material to be sent to you;
- complete one of our enquiry forms; or
- provide us with feedback.

When and how we share information with others

Your information may be shared with:

1. IT service providers who provide cloud-based solutions, data storage, processing, back-up and retrieval services.
2. Sub-contractors or associates who are asked by Infosec Cloud to deliver all or some of the services.
3. Vendors, Distributors, and manufacturers of products and services that we sell.

We do not sell personal information to anyone and only share it with third parties who are facilitating the delivery of our services and communications.

Data about customers and employees of our clients

We process data provided to us by our clients in our capacity as Data Processors. We process this data strictly on instructions of our clients (Data Controllers) who provide us with access to such data. We abide by the privacy and security requirements as per the contractual arrangements with the Data Controllers. We follow, and are fully committed to fulfil, our obligations as a Data Processor for data privacy, data security, and breach notifications.

Visitors to our Website

When you visit our website, we use third-party services and cookies to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to various parts of the website. The information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone.

When you complete a contact form on our website or use the email for enquiries, we will use the information provided by you only for providing you with an appropriate response.



Marketing Data

We hold name and contact details of individuals who have expressed interest in hearing from us about our services or have engaged with us for supply of our services in the past. We also process details of individuals where such information is obtained from third parties with whom you have consented for your information to be shared with us. We process such data for our legitimate business interests of providing information on services and products to the users in the businesses that we serve.

We ensure that all direct marketing activities to such individuals are proportionate, reasonable, relevant and comply with relevant privacy and regulatory requirements. We also ensure that the recipients are provided with clear options to unsubscribe from such marketing activities.

Security of your information

In addition, we train our employees about the importance of confidentiality and maintaining the privacy and security of your information. We commit to taking appropriate disciplinary measures to enforce our employees' privacy responsibilities.

We also get our systems independently assessed to ensure that we have good security measures in place.

Data storage and retention

Your personal data is stored by Infosec Cloud on its servers, and on the servers of the cloud-services providers we engage, as well as in physical forms in our office and at backup and archival facilities. We retain data for the duration of the customer's business relationship with us and as per the regulatory, legal, or reporting requirements.
